*Deacon: That we may complete the remaining time of our life in peace and repentance, let us ask of the Lord.*



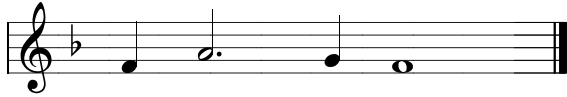
Grant it, O Lord.

*Deacon: A Christian ending to our life; painless, blameless, and peaceful; and a good defense before the dread judgment seat of Christ, let us ask of the Lord.*



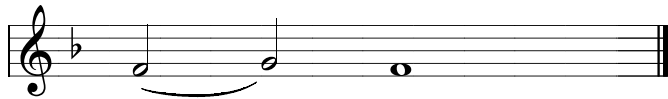
Grant it, O Lord.
