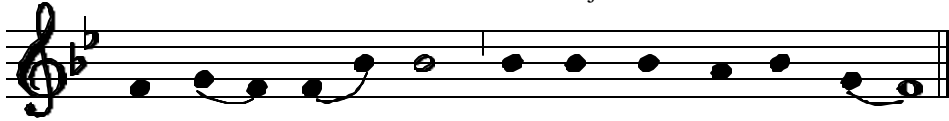


Evening Prayer Gospel Canticle
